Topic overview

Autumn	Castles This project incorporates the use of timelines and information about royal palaces, portraits and other historical sources to allow the children to compare life in the past and life now. They build up an understanding of the monarchs and have a chance to visit Windsor Castle.
Spring	Oh, we do like to be beside the seaside This project teaches children about the physical and human features of coastal regions across the United Kingdom, including a detailed exploration of the coastal town of St Ives.
Summer	Explorers of the world This project teaches children about historically significant people who have had a major impact on the world. They will learn to use timelines, stories and historical sources to find out about the people featured and use historical models to explore their significance.

School uniform and PE Kit
